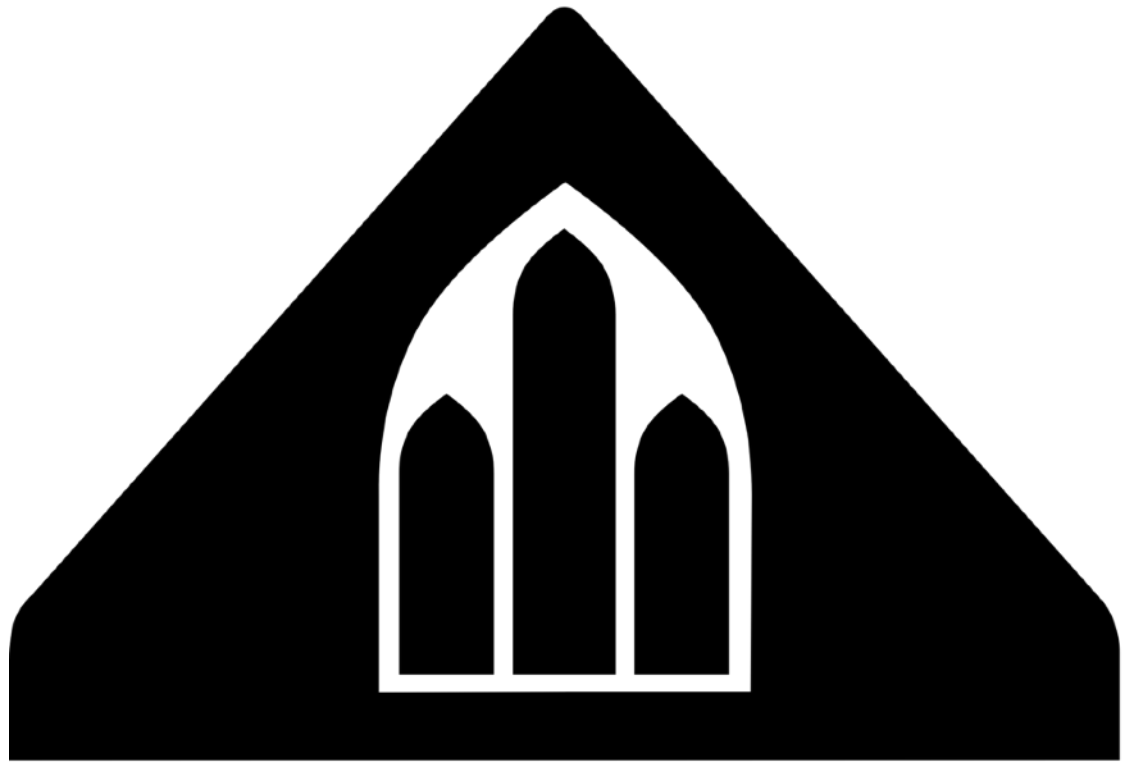

## **So, You Think Things Are Bad Now?**

Each year on June 19th, the New Church commemorates an event that, according to Emanuel Swedenborg, marks the beginning of a new spiritual era: the Lord's Second Coming—not in the clouds of the physical sky, but in the deeper truths revealed from the Word, and in the renewed freedom given to humankind. But as we reflect on this day, it's easy to look at our world and think: *If this is the New Church age, why does everything still seem so broken?*

It's a fair question. We see division, injustice, moral confusion, and rising secularism. But consider this: *how bad was it before?*

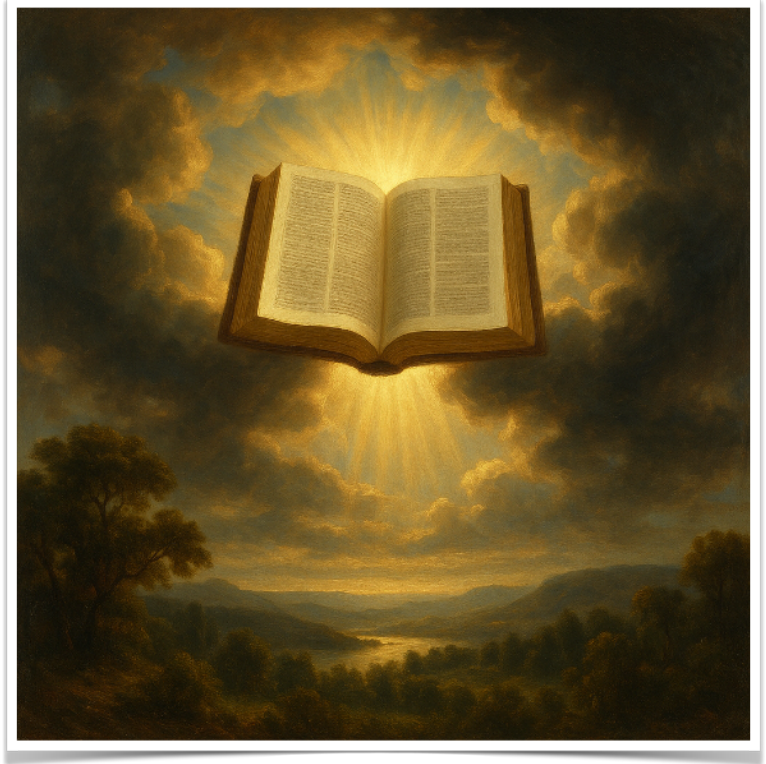
## **A World in Spiritual Darkness**

Swedenborg was clear: in his time, the Christian world was in a state of profound spiritual decline. He describes a church where faith had become little more than a slogan—"faith alone saves"—repeated without understanding or transformation. People could recite creeds but had lost the ability to inwardly acknowledge that the Lord Jesus Christ is the Divine Human.



In fact, many Christian leaders, when asked whether they could unite the ideas of the “divine” and “human” in Jesus, simply could not. Swedenborg calls this a form of hidden Arianism: a denial of the Lord’s divinity, clothed in outward religiosity (TCR 111).

In *True Christian Religion* 391, Swedenborg recounts angels lamenting the state of the church: most Christians knew only of a trinity of persons and the idea of faith as the sole requirement for salvation. They had little concept of the Lord’s unity with the Father, little understanding of Scripture’s spiritual meaning, and little awareness of how life after death actually works. Swedenborg saw the church as existing in a desert—a barren landscape devoid of living faith and understanding.



And yet, despite this desolation, Swedenborg wrote with hope: a new dawn was coming. Not a cataclysmic ending, but a spiritual renewal. Not an apocalyptic end, but a heavenly beginning.

### **A New Morning: The Second Coming**

According to Swedenborg, the Lord’s Second Coming is not a return in the flesh but a coming in *the spirit and truth* of the Word. It is the unveiling of Scripture’s inner meaning

and the restoration of a genuine, living Christianity. On June 19, 1770, Swedenborg wrote that the Lord called together His twelve disciples in the spiritual world and sent them out to proclaim this new era—the New Church.



What changed?

The spiritual barriers that once prevented people from seeing the Lord clearly have been removed. Divine truth is now available in greater fullness. The clouds (the literal meaning of the Word) now shine with glory (its spiritual meaning). The old structures—like ancient temples buried under centuries

of dust—have been uncovered, revealing altars of gold and sacred spaces once hidden (TCR 669).

This new revelation has restored the possibility of true conjunction: a real marriage of goodness and truth in the human heart. The Lord as Bridegroom now calls to His Bride—the New Church—in every soul willing to hear. And while not everyone answers the call, the voice rings out more clearly than ever.

## **Have Things Gotten Better?**

Surprisingly, yes.

While much remains broken, we now live in an age where spiritual freedom has been restored. People of all backgrounds can explore Scripture's deeper meanings. The

idea of God as One—fully revealed in the Lord Jesus Christ—is no longer rare. The understanding that religion is not just belief, but a life lived in love and service, is being reclaimed. More and more people, even outside formal religion, are turning toward compassion, justice, and inner transformation. These are fruits of the Lord's new presence.

It may not be a utopia, but compared to the spiritual night of Swedenborg's time, the dawn has broken. The sun is rising. We are in the morning of a new age.

**But...**

But this does not mean we rest.

The Lord has cleared the path, but He will not walk it for us. The truths of the Second Coming place us in a new kind of freedom—the freedom to live as truly spiritual people. But it is our choice whether we will walk that path.

We each have ongoing work to do. To reject evils as sins. To live a life of love toward the neighbour. To worship the Lord not just outwardly, but inwardly, by letting His love and wisdom transform our hearts and lives.

The Second Coming has happened. The Lord is present. The clouds are parting. The question is not “Where is He?” The question is, “Will we follow?”

# **WHAT IF THE WORLD HAD NEVER SEEN VAN GOGH'S ART?**

When Johanna “Jo” van Gogh married Theo van Gogh, she couldn’t have imagined she’d change art history. Within two years, both her husband and his brother Vincent were gone—one to illness, the other to despair.

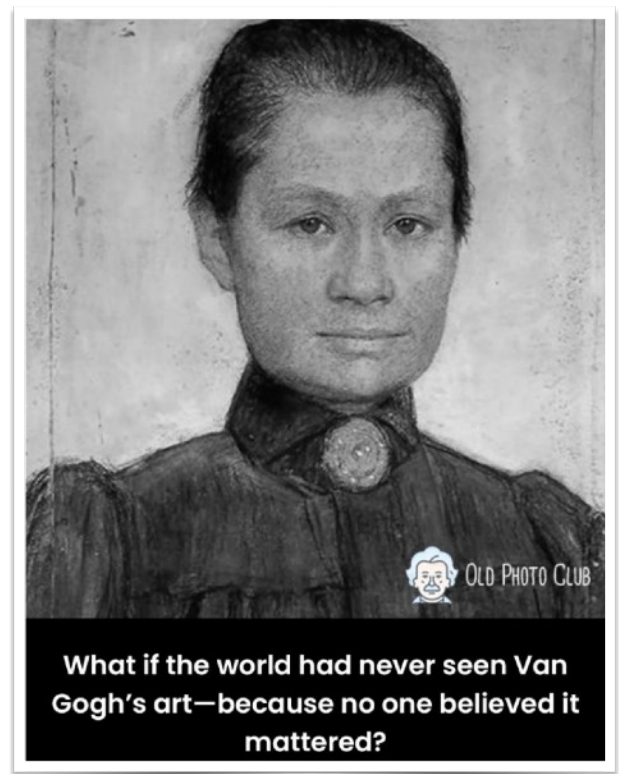
Left a widow at 28 with an infant son and hundreds of unsold paintings by a little-known artist, Jo could’ve walked away. Vincent had sold almost nothing during his lifetime. Critics had dismissed him. To most, the paintings were worthless.

But Jo saw more than just canvas and paint—she saw Vincent’s soul in every brushstroke. She read his letters, filled with hope, suffering, and passion, and knew his story had to be told.

She moved back to the Netherlands, ran a boarding house to survive, and began quietly organising exhibitions. More importantly, she shared the letters between Vincent and Theo—revealing a mind full of brilliance, not madness. Slowly, the world began to listen.

In 1905, Jo curated the first major Van Gogh retrospective in Amsterdam. It changed everything. Critics reevaluated him. Museums began acquiring his work. His name spread far beyond Europe.

Today, Vincent van Gogh is one of the most celebrated artists in



history. But it was Jo who made that possible. Her quiet resolve turned obscurity into immortality. Without her, the world may have never seen *Starry Night* or *Sunflowers*. Her story reminds us: legacies are often built not just by those who create—but by those who believe.

Across numerous platforms, from engaging Facebook pages to insightful YouTube channels, visually stunning Instagram accounts, thought-provoking X feeds, and even audio explorations on SoundCloud and TikTok, individuals are sharing their perspectives, insights, and creativity inspired by Swedenborg's teachings.

Just like the critics who initially dismissed Van Gogh, it can be easy to scroll past, to not fully appreciate the dedication and passion poured into these online creations. But what if we, as a community, actively chose to be "Johannas" for these modern-day storytellers and thinkers?

We have a unique opportunity to nurture and amplify the voices within our network. We've identified a wealth of content out there: 40 Facebook pages, 32 YouTube

channels, 29 Instagram accounts, 9 X accounts, 2 SoundCloud accounts, 2 TikTok accounts, and even 1 Substack account. Some creators, like SCV, may even have a presence on multiple platforms – simply pick the platform that suits you best!

Here's how we can collectively make a difference, step by step:

1. **Find Your Focus:** Explore the SSMN landscape and find the Swedenborgian channels or pages - just one or two - that genuinely interest you, so you're not overwhelmed.
2. **Connect:** Subscribe, Follow, or Like their page. Each platform has its own way of connecting, so choose the relevant option.
3. **Engage with New Content:** When you receive notifications about new content, take a moment to watch, read, or listen to the content that interests you.
4. **Show Appreciation:** Click that Like button! It's a small gesture that means a lot to creators.
5. **Spark a Conversation:** Leave a Comment! Pose a question, share what you enjoyed about it, or even suggest a future topic. Anything that contributes to the conversation is valuable.
6. **Amplify Their Reach:** If the platform allows, share the content to your own page so your network can discover it too.
7. **Spread the Word:** If you come across content that you think might be helpful or of interest to your friends, recommend it to them directly.

Let's learn from Jo's extraordinary example. Let's be the believers, the encouragers, the champions of the talented individuals within the Swedenborg Social Media Network. Our collective support can transform dedicated creators into influential voices. Let's build our own legacy of recognition, together.

## **Christine Gospodarczyk**

### **Beloved Ballet Mistress**

Christine passed on this last weekend after several months of cancer. Her part in the Roseville New Church has been considerable, varied and over three decades and more. It all goes back to a school friendship in the early 1990s between our son and her son which brought us all together. We became regularly in touch.

Christine was a longstanding ballet and dance teacher in Sydney, and a very good teacher and choreographer, getting excellent results in the world of



dance and in eisteddfods and exams. She had a lot of contacts in the ballet world and she set a high standard for her students to carry through.



Two things took place in the mid-1990s. The first was that Christine applied to rent the church hall after school during the week, a move which expanded to become a considerably large ballet and dance activity, later on involving Tarkett flooring and bars on one wall. The

Roseville Ballet and Performing Arts Studio. The quality of this shone out, most of all, at the annual Ballet Concerts in Glen Street Theatre, much enjoyed and appreciated by parents, and continuing over very many years till recently. She also hired several excellent teachers.

The other development was the start of our weekly Saturday late afternoon Angel Service in the church, from 1995 onwards. Christine was soon there and appreciatively comparing the approach we took with the rigours and guilts of the religion in which she grew up, over in New Zealand. Christine mentioned the Angel Service to friends and this led to others joining.

In the early 2010s Christine told me one afternoon out the back of the church hall - we met most days by chance, somewhere on site - and said that she would like to become a member of the church. I talked with her and it quickly became clear she was spiritually completely at home with

us. In her own twinkling way, she said, "Oh, I'm not after a cheaper rent!"

Christine had to cope with several medical issues over the years, and eventually decided to step back and pass the running of the ballet school to her daughter, Sophie, less than two years ago.

Our love and condolences extend to her children Toby and Sophie, their partners and her two

grandchildren. Our families were very close and we got to know some of her close friends too. We will all miss her, but know that she will be able to move freely and dance again.

### 150<sup>th</sup> SSNC Celebrations / sesquicentenary

As part of the Sesquicentenary (150th) birthday celebrations of The Sydney Society of the New Church, distinguished guests, the historian and entrepreneur Dr. Jonathan King and his wife Jane plan to hand over to us a historical document which they have kept safe since 1988 when Dr. King conceived and organised the highly successful public re-enactment of the sailing of the First Fleet from Plymouth (UK) and the landing in Sydney Harbour, to commemorate the original landing of 1788. That event happened to coincide with Swedenborg's 1688 birth. Captain James Cook had set sail after spending 3 days with his friend William Cookworthy, an ardent student, translator and promoter of

Swedenborg's spiritual writings. It is interesting to note that the later First Fleet contained a set of the spiritual works of Swedenborg, and as a result this set was also carried on board the re-enactment fleet.

If the opportunity allows (probably a night in early October 2025), we would love Dr. King to give a short account of his significant history project. Stay tuned for more information.

### First Monday of the Month Free Spiritual Movies

The Roseville New Church was recently the place for a lively gathering of movie-goers, who enjoyed their free popcorn, Jaffas and Maltesers while watching the first spiritual movie of a series of titles which will be screened for free on the first Monday of each month at 6:30pm.

The series of movie titles (screened under licence) are:

1. (May 5<sup>th</sup>) **Seventh Seal** (1957). Swedish black and white movie by Ingmar Bergman (already shown).
2. (June 2<sup>nd</sup>) **As It Is In Heaven** (2004). Swedish movie about a music conductor who takes a mental health break in his childhood country town.
3. (July 7<sup>th</sup>) **What Dreams May Come** (1998, famous movie by Robin Williams, Cuba Gooding Jr)
4. (August 4<sup>th</sup>) **Things Seen and Heard** (2021). About Swedenborg's *Heaven and Hell*.
5. (September 1<sup>st</sup>) **La Belle Verte** (1996, French). Amusing but insightful film, written, directed by, and starring Coline Serreau, which follows an alien woman visiting Paris from a heavenly green planet, shocked by humanity's neglect of nature. This film blends

environmental themes with a sharp critique of consumerism.

- 6.(October 6<sup>th</sup>) ***Spring, Summer, Fall, Winter... and Spring***, 2003. Korean movie directed by Kim Ki-duk about cycles of life, spiritual purification and karma. This film deals with spiritual evolution, and with nature as a correspondence of the soul's growth.
- 7.(November 3<sup>rd</sup>) ***City of Angels***, 1998. A classic film about angels present with us, starring Nicholas Cage and Meg Ryan.
- 8.(December 1<sup>st</sup>) ***It's a Wonderful Life***, 1946. An enduring Christmas fantasy about an angel who saves a man's life, starring James Stewart as George Bailey.
